- 3. 文檢及秘訣亦稱玉訣: 科儀規則, 敘錄秘傳正統的紅印道教儀式
- 4. **神霄及盧山**: 依自然的通俗儀式,這是來自非經典規範的作法,同時被視為邪派之儀式。

臺灣道眾將道教分為兩派,即依其為生者或往生者提供之法事性質之不同或以祈禱、符咒、驅邪及治病或作喪葬之科儀之不同而分為烏頭與紅頭派。
